

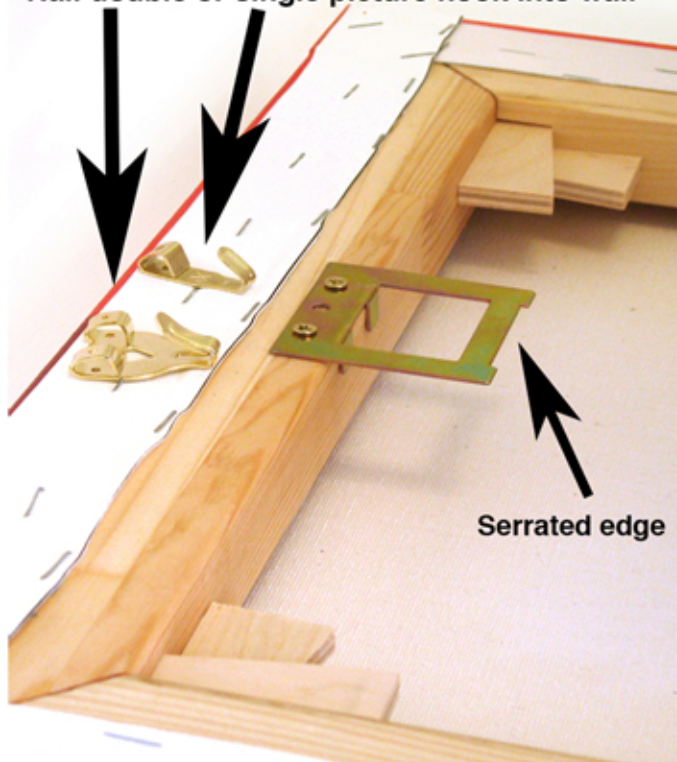
# Hanging Your Canvas

Hanging your canvas level on the wall could not be simpler, thanks to our clever bracket design.

Once the picture hook is nailed into the wall, slide the serrated edge on the bottom of the bracket onto the hook. The hook will sit inside the bracket and slide the canvas back for a snug fit against the wall.

If you prefer the canvas to sit a few millimetres away from the wall, attach the four cork bumpers supplied, either to the wood frame or on the folded canvas.

For sizes up to A2 (16" x 24") and for good quality walls we recommend either single or double nail picture hooks.

For sizes above A2, or if your wall is poor quality always use a double nail hook or seek advice.

For larger size frames we usually fit two brackets, so draw a level line on the wall and mark off the same distance as between the centres of the two brackets on your picture. Nail the two picture hooks onto the line, centered on these marks.

Once on the wall, the bracket will sit over the hook like this

If you prefer to use a nail hammered into the wall (perhaps already in place), we recommend resting the upper wooden frame on the nail, with the nail through the hole in the bracket. Make sure the nail protrudes from the wall less than the thickness of the frame.
